Dear Committee Members:

Our organizations are looking to meet the West Parry Sound Area Recreation Complex application for funding through the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program (ICIP). We are looking for the West Parry Sound Area Recreation Complex Committee to consider adding our organizations as joint applicants. We understand our request for land for affordable housing would be better directed to the Town of Parry Sound.

Having our organizations added as joint applicants will enable you to receive additional consideration under Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program as part of the assessment process due to the following considerations:

- Joint projects, particularly those that service multiple communities,
- Focus on vulnerable populations and Indigenous people,
- Alignment with Provincial Objectives, and
- Community employment benefits for at least three federal targeted groups.

Under the new ICIP Community, Culture, and Recreational (CCR) stream, we have the opportunity to work together to access 93.33% in funding.

Approximately \$407 million in federal funding and \$320 million in provincial funding will be available for the CCR stream over ten years starting in 2019-20. At least \$30 million of federal funding must be carved out for off-reserve Indigenous projects (source: Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program: Community, Culture and Recreation Stream, <http://www.grants.gov.on.ca>).

We look forward to working with the committee to benefit our communities.
